## 2007-2008 REGISTRATION FEE RATES

Students will attend an assembly conducted by their grade-level counselors on Monday, March 10<sup>th</sup>, to explain the course selections, electives and registration for the 2008-2009 school year. Students will bring home a registration packet that day with the following information:

- ❖ Completed grade level course selection to be signed by a parent/guardian.
- ❖ 2008-2009 Tuition and Fee contract.
- ❖ \$550.00 registration fee
- ❖ Emergency card (both sides)

**All of the above must be signed by a parent in order to be registered for next year.**

The deadline to turn in all the above information is Wednesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2008. The registration fee of \$550 must accompany the tuition and fee contract. Reminder: the registration fee will go up after the due date as follows:

- April 14<sup>th</sup> thru May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008 - \$600
- After May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008 - \$650
